Meet Our Beloved Stardust



Stardust is our beloved white donkey. This month, he has been a Winslow Farm resident for 25 years!

He had a very difficult life before being rescued by Winslow Farm. He was bought by the farm from a meat auction where he was destined to be slaughtered for food.



At the auction, he was whipped and dragged around with chains because he would not walk as he was told. Stardust struggled when walking because he suffered from a bad case of Founder, caused by his former owner neglecting to trim his hooves. His hooves began to curl up and it was very painful for him to walk. That day, Debra White was determined to save his life. It took her until midnight before she could find transport to bring him to Winslow Farm. Once home, he was given a second chance in life. He was welcomed to the farm with love and care.

Stardust settled in quite well since. He has happily lived at the farm and become friends with Zorro, the other male donkey. They often will play for some time, playing tug of war with bowls or the tarp from the tractor! Jezebel, the female donkey, trails after Stardust, wherever he goes.

This year saw a potentially serious situation where we almost lost Stardust. He came down with a very bad ailment and had to be rushed to Tufts in the equine ambulance. After a stay of about a week, he was once again home and has recovered well, for which we are so grateful.
